The Electricity (Applications for Consent) Regulations 1990: Regulation 5 - Publication of Notice of Application for Consent under Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a application is being made by Western Power Distribution (South West) plc to the Secretary of State at the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy under Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989, for their consent to erect two terminal towers in the existing 132,000 volt overhead lines known as the AE route at Seabrook Orchard, Exeter EX2 7EU. (295391, 089423 & 295936, 089621)

The proposed new towers are necessary to facilitate an underground diversion of the existing AE line due to the construction of a housing development in this location. It is proposed that two sections of overhead line and two existing towers will be dismantled.
