

## Invitation to a Distributed Generation stakeholder workshop, followed by lunch: 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2015 at Birmingham's Villa Park

I am writing to invite you to WPD's dedicated stakeholder workshop on distributed generation, hosted at Villa Park, Birmingham.

Distributed generation (DG) is an electricity generating plant that is connected to WPD's network, rather than the transmission network. In recent years, we have seen a huge rise in the number of DG connections and this trend is set to continue. We recognise that connecting customers to the electricity network is a critical activity that delivers benefits both to individual customers and to society more broadly.

As the volume of connections increases there are new challenges for us to overcome to ensure that we continue to manage and adapt the connections process so it works for our customers. As a key stakeholder, we would be very interested to get your feedback on how we can continue to address these challenges as we move towards a decarbonised energy sector.

We will cover a range of topics including customer service improvements, innovative connections, transmission/distribution interface issues (Statement of Works) and commercial issues including queue management. In the afternoon, there will be an opportunity for attendees to participate in more detailed 'surgeries'.
